Recommendations

Key Facts

- The purpose of this report is to approve the selected recipient of the T. Roy Adams Humanitarian of the Year Award for 2021.
- In memory of the late Councillor T. Roy Adams, Niagara Region initiated a memorial award in his name to honour a resident of Niagara who exemplifies dedication to community service and volunteerism.
- Confidential Appendix 1 of this report contains the results of the 2021 T. Roy Adams Humanitarian Award Committee Nominations Evaluation Matrix.
- The 2021 Evaluation Matrix was circulated to members for use during the consideration of the 2021 nominees and to determine the recipient of the award.

Financial Considerations

In addition, there are nominal fees associated with a keeper plaque for the award recipient and the engraving of the large plaque that is kept outside of the Council Chamber.
