BY-LAW NO. <>

A BY-LAW TO ACCEPT, ASSUME AND DEDICATE PART OF LIVINGSTON AVENUE, PLAN 441, IN THE TOWN OF GRIMSBY AS PART OF REGIONAL ROAD NO. 512 (LIVINGSTON AVENUE)

WHEREAS subsection 52(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that an upper-tier municipality may add a lower-tier highway to its highway system from any of its lower-tier municipalities;

WHEREAS Regional Council wishes to add a portion of Livingston Avenue (also referred to as Livingstone Avenue) in the Town of Grimsby to the Regional highway system;

WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to accept, assume and dedicate the lands hereinafter described as part of the public highway being Regional Road No. 512 (Livingston Avenue).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of Niagara enacts as follows:

1. That the portion of the road described as follows be and is hereby removed from the highway system of the Town of Grimsby and added to the Regional highway system, and the same is hereby accepted, assumed and dedicated as public highway forming part of the said Regional Road No. 512 (Livingston Avenue):

Part of Livingstone Avenue, being Livingstone Avenue, Plan 441, Town of Grimsby, Regional Municipality of Niagara.

2. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the day upon which it is passed.
