Procurement By-law: (Q3-2021)

Substantive changes to the By-law - removing procedural content.
 Recommend a continued focus remain on completing the newly proposed training initiative Committee for their review and comment.

Procurement Templates: Version 4.0: (Q1-2021)

 Procurement has acquired and are awaiting receipt of templates from the Procurement Office at which time they will implemented by Procurement.

Vendor Performance Management: (Q2-2020)

 Procurement will build upon the Public Works pilot for contractor performance and present recommendations for vendor performance management for goods, services (consulting) and construction.
