A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2020-62,
BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2017-56,
BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE
THE USE OF THE WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM
FOR THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIAGARA.

WHEREAS on April 11, 1996, Regional Council adopted By-laws 8280-96, 8281-96 and 8282-96 to assume from the twelve area municipalities all waste management powers conferred by any Act upon the area municipalities;

WHEREAS Section 11(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, ("the Act") provides that an upper tier municipality may pass By-laws respecting waste management subject to the requirements set out in the Act;

WHEREAS By-law No. 2017-56 was passed by Regional Council on May 15, 2017, to regulate the use of the waste management system for the Regional Municipality of Niagara;

WHEREAS Regional Council deemed it advisable to amend By-law No. 2017-56;

WHEREAS By-law 2020-62, was passed by Regional Council on September 17, 2020, being a by-law to amend By-law 2017-56; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 2020-62 omitted wording to be presented to Council for approval, specifically in Section 13, Collection Limits and Procedure for Garbage Exemptions.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of Niagara enacts as follows:

1. That Section 13, Collection Limits and Procedure for Garbage Exemptions, be amended to read as follows:
 - 13.1 (g) an Owner of Type C-D Premises may set out for collection a maximum of four (4) **Garbage Containers** weekly;

- 13.1 (i) an Owner of Type E and F Premises may set out for collection a maximum of eight (8) **Garbage** Containers every-other-week;
2. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the day upon which it is passed.
