A BY-LAW TO APPOINT AN INTERIM INTEGRITY COMMISSIONER FOR THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIAGARA AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW 2017-61

WHEREAS section 223.3(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, authorizes The Regional Municipality of Niagara to appoint an Integrity Commissioner who reports to council and who is responsible for performing, in an independent manner, the functions assigned by the municipality with respect to any or all of the matters enumerated in section 223.3(1);

WHEREAS on July 6, 2017, Regional Council passed a resolution that Edward T. McDermott of ADR Chambers Inc., be appointed as the Integrity Commissioner for The Regional Municipality of Niagara, based on his unique qualifications for the position;

WHEREAS on May 21, 2021, notice was received from Mr. McDermott advising of his intention to resign from his appointed position as Integrity Commissioner for The Regional Municipality of Niagara, which will be effective on June 24, 2021;

WHEREAS ADR Chambers Inc., and the current Integrity Commissioner recommend Michael L. Maynard for appointment as Interim Integrity Commissioner based on his qualifications until such time as a new Integrity Commissioner may be appointed pursuant to a competitive procurement process.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of Niagara enacts as follows:

- 1. That Michael Maynard of ADR Chambers Inc., shall be appointed as the Interim Integrity Commissioner for The Regional Municipality of Niagara until such time as a new Integrity Commissioner is appointed.
- 2. That By-law 2017-61 is hereby repealed.
