I respectfully add my voice in support of better public transportation for Niagara on the Lake. Both residents of Niagara Region and visitors would benefit from a robust public transportation system to and from Niagara on the Lake. The current system is inadequate for service workers, those on fixed income, or those who support a "Green" alternative to driving a car. Tourists to our region have limited options for independent travel between our towns. As Chair of the Niagara Pumphouse Arts Centre at 247 Ricardo St. our participants tell us our location is "cut off" and hard to access from those who would like to visit our gallery or take part in classes or special events.

Better public transportation to the area would increase accessibility.
