Subject: Update Regarding 2022 Schedule of Fees and Charges

The purpose of this memo is to describe an error discovered in the 2022 schedule of fees and charges as presented at the December 9, 2021 Budget Review Committee of the Whole (BRC).

In 2019, the Niagara Regional Transit (NRT) service plan transferred Port Colborne's Link service to the Region. Prior to this upload, the City of Port Colborne increased the Link fare from \$3.50 to \$4.00. The Region's fees and charges by-law did not receive a corresponding update at that time and has continued to reflect \$3.50. Staff are preparing for NRT OnDemand to become the transit provider in Port Colborne as of January 3, 2022 and noticed the oversight. To correct for this, the following Transit fees have been updated from \$3.50 to \$4.00 on the 2022 schedule of fees and charges (this has no impact on riders, as they have been correctly charged a fare of \$4.00 since prior to the upload from Port Colborne):

- PW-136 Port Colborne to Welland Link Service Cash Fare Adults (18-64)
- PW-137 Port Colborne to Welland Link Service Cash Fare Youth (13-17) / High School Students
- PW-138 Port Colborne to Welland Link Service Cash Fare Seniors (65+)

Staff have also noted that Niagara Specialized Transit (NST) does not have a Link service. All trips are inter-municipal, door-to-door, and therefore the standard NST fares apply. As such, the following fees have been deleted from the schedule:

- PW-159 Trips Fort Erie to Niagara Falls Link Service Cash Fare Adults (18-64)
- PW-160 Trips Fort Erie to Niagara Falls Link Service Cash Fare Youth (13-17) / High School Students
- PW-161 Trips Fort Erie to Niagara Falls Link Service Cash Fare Seniors (65+)

- PW-162 Trips Port Colborne to Welland Link Service Cash Fare Adults (18-64)
- PW-163 Trips Port Colborne to Welland Link Service Cash Fare Youth (13-17) / High School Students
- PW-164 Trips Port Colborne to Welland Link Service Cash Fare Seniors (65+)

These changes are reflected in the appendix to Bill No. 2021-114, the by-law to establish fees and charges, which is also on tonight's agenda.
