### Regional Official Plan Amendment Application Area

- Northwest corner of Niven Road and Niagara Stone Road, Niagara-on-the-Lake
  - North of Stratus Vineyards, to the west of "The Village"
- Approximately 16.2 hectares in area
- Frontage on Hunter Road, Niagara Stone Road and Niven Road





### Purpose of the Regional Official Plan Amendment Application

To permit a new private sanitary connection outside of the Urban Area Boundary






### Regional Official Plan Policy 5.C.5

"Developments outside the urban area boundaries will not be provided with municipal...sewer services but instead will be expected to depend on private sewage disposal systems."

#### **Approval Process**

- The Region is the approval authority for the Regional Official Plan Amendment
  - At a future meeting, a recommendation report will be brought to Planning and Economic Development Committee for consideration
- The Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake is the approval authority for the Zoning By-law Amendment
  - Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake staff take a recommendation report to their Town Council for consideration
