Who We Are

- GGO is the official organization representing all 500 processing grape growers including 183 wineries on 18,000 acres of vineyards in the province.
- 95% of production is in Niagara.
- \$4.4 billion of economic impact;
 \$847 million tourism impact; 2.4 million tourists.





Agriculture is Important Culturally and Economically

In Niagara:

- \$383.8 million gross farm receipts
- \$1.4 billion gross domestic product impact
- 19,892 jobs

Niagara's Specialty Crop Land

- Niagara's Specialty Crop land is unique and recognized in the Greenbelt Plan as a finite resource to be protected through productive agriculture.
- Dismissing our impact and importance is incredibly short-sighted
- The priorities of the Region and Province are not recognized in the current proposal to eliminate the exemption for agricultural buildings





Potential Impact

- Example of a simple 40 ft x 60 ft metal storage building costing \$50,000 to purchase
- New development charge at \$8.76 per square foot = \$21,024
- 40% of the cost of the building.







Niagara Region Agricultural Policy and Action Committee (APAC)

- Forum to facilitate consultation on issues impacting agriculture
- APAC should have been consulted on this issue or provided with the full report, given the significance of development charges on the industry
