BY-LAW NO. <>

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIAGARA TO PROVIDE A MATCHING REDUCTION OR REFUND OF THE REGIONAL PORTION OF PROPERTY TAXES FOR ELIGIBLE PROPERTIES UNDER THE TOWN OF FORT ERIE HERITAGE TAX REBATE PROGRAM AND REPEAL BY-LAW 36-2008

WHEREAS in accordance with Section 365.2 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25 as amended, the Town of Fort Erie passed By-law No.157-2021, on December 13, 2021, being a by-law to provide for tax refunds or reductions in respect of eligible heritage property; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 365.2 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, an upper-tier municipality may pass a by-law to authorize a similar reduction or refund of taxes levied for upper-tier purposes; and

WHEREAS the Town of Fort Erie has requested that The Regional Municipality of Niagara match the Town of Fort Erie percentage refund or reduction on each eligible heritage property participating in the Town Heritage Properites Tax Rebate Program.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of Niagara enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Region match the Town of Fort Erie percentage refund or reduction on each eligible heritage property participating in the Town Heritage Properties Tax Rebate Program; and
- 2. That By-law 36-2008 is hereby repealed.
