BY-LAW NO. <>

A BY-LAW TO REMOVE A PORTION OF HIGHWAY
FROM THE REGIONAL ROAD SYSTEM IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF WEST LINCOLN (SOUTH GRIMSBY
ROAD 10)

WHEREAS subsection 27 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O.2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws in respect of highway under its jurisdiction.

WHEREAS subsection 52(4) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O.2001, c.25, as amended, provides that The Regional Municipality of Niagara may remove a highway from its Regional Road system.

WHEREAS subsection 52(5) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O.2001, c.25 provides that where a highway is removed from the Regional Road system, such highway is thereupon under the jurisdiction of the lower-tier municipality in which the highway is located; and,

WHEREAS Regional Council deems it desirable to remove a portion of South Grimsby Road 10, the said lands described as Part of Lot 19, Concession 9, Township of West Lincoln, Regional Municipality of Niagara and being designated as Parts 10 to 14 on Plan 30R-15936, as the lands are the jurisdiction of the Township of West Lincoln.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of Niagara enacts as follows:

1. That the following lands be and the same are hereby removed from the Regional Road system:

FIRSTLY:

Part of Lot 19, Concession 9, South Grimsby, Township of West Lincoln, Regional Municipality of Niagara and being designated as Part 10 on Plan 30R-15936.

SECONDLY:

Part of Lot 19, Concession 9, South Grimsby, Township of West Lincoln, Regional Municipality of Niagara and being designated as Parts 11-14 on Plan 30R-15936.

2. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the day upon which it is passed.
