Presentation Details

I would like to speak in support of this motion. In my experience, the rising levels of hate and intolerance have absolutely had a detrimental effect on our community as a whole. It is keeping many people from running for politics and for even engaging in politics. I would like to see a public education program implemented, and a clear code of conduct for citizens. I know the city of Elliot Lake discussed a citizen code of conduct at one time and I'm looking in to where that stands currently.
