





The Importance of Government Relations

- Niagara is one of 444 municipalities in Ontario and 3,573 in Canada advocating for increased support from upper levels of government
- Opportunities for direct government-to-government engagement is limited throughout the year
- Effective government relations (GR):
 - Supports positive intergovernmental relationships
 - Ensures Regional perspectives are considered in policy and program decisions
 - Allows for a consistent and unified narrative when engaging with upper levels of government
 - Aligns advocacy work with provincial and federal priorities to move initiatives forward

2023 Corporate Advocacy Priorities

- South Niagara Wastewater Solutions Project
 - Request: One-third funding for the estimated \$400M project
- Consolidated Housing Master Plan
 - o **Request:** Long-term capital funding to increase the supply of community housing units
- Shared Services
 - Request: Reintroduction of the Municipal Modernization Program with a focus on shared service implementation between two-tier municipalities
- EMS Offloading Delays
 - Request: Reimbursement for emergency EMS funding and identify long-term solutions for offload delay challenges
