
Regional Official Plan Amendment

- North of Highway 3, east of Greybiel Road, and west of the existing quarry operation








Regional Official Plan Amendment

Purpose of Application:

- Add a site-specific policy and map to the Regional Official Plan to permit the proposed quarry extension
- Add the subject lands on Schedule H – "Known Deposits of Mineral Aggregate Resources and Mineral Aggregate Operations" as "Licensed Aggregate Operations".

Concurrent Applications

Township of Wainfleet

 Applications for a Local Official Plan Amendment and a Zoning By-law Amendment were also submitted to the Township of Wainfleet

Aggregate Resources Act

- An application was also filed by the applicant for a licence under the Aggregate Resources Act (ARA)
- The Province is the approval authority for the ARA Licence – which cannot be granted until the municipal Planning Act approvals are in place
- A Joint Agency Review Team (JART) was formed. Region, Township, and NPCA Staff worked together to review all the applications concurrently.





Approval Process

- Regional Council is the approval authority for the Regional Official Plan Amendment (ROPA)
- Regional Council is the approval authority for the Township of Wainfleet Official Plan Amendment (LOPA)
 - Township Council adopted the LOPA on July 9, 2024
 - Township Council requested Regional Council approve the LOPA
- Township of Wainfleet Council is the approval authority for the Zoning By-Law Amendment (ZBLA)
 - Township Council approved the ZBLA on July 9, 2024
