Regional Partnership Opportunities

Cash Partnership

- We respect that the Niagara Region and its municipalities receive many requests for cash support of local events.
- Traditionally, the IPM host region has been requested to make a \$0.25 sponsorship commitment for each resident of the Region.
- IPM 2025 asking for a cash sponsorship of approximately \$0.129 per resident.
- This equates to a \$55 000 cash sponsorship to accompany the \$15 000 ask we are making to the three local municipalities (West Lincoln, Lincoln and Grimsby).
- This would bring the total cash contribution between municipalities and Region to \$100 000.

In-Kind Sponsorship

- An event like this requires significant coordination with the IPM 2025
 Local Committee and the host municipalities and Region.
- West Lincoln, Lincoln and Grimsby have all received an ask for in-kind support tied to how the IPM 2025 overlaps with their municipality and the services they can provide to the event.
- The IPM 2025 has consulted with the OPA and previous IPM Host Communities. The attached list outlines the key areas where the Region and its services are required to make this event a success.

Niagara Region In-Kind Sponsorship Request

Public Works, Public Heath, Planning, Economic Development -

- Provide permission to use the region owned property on Mud Street (north of Niagara Region Landfill on Regional Road 12)
- Work proactively with IPM 2025 Local committee to promote the event including support from regional economic development staff/resources
- Replace culvert on Grimsby Mountain Road (40') to support RV park entrance
- Replace other culverts as required to support event (once final parking and traffic management plan is complete)
- Waive costs of permits and inspections for water and sewage
- Provide resources to remove grey/black water from site as required
- Waive dumping fees for grey water, black water and garbage
- Supply recycle and garbage bins (including pickup)
- Install/removing snow fence as required (IPM 2025 can supply event owned snow fence)
- Confirm event requirements and provide support to ensure all permits and plans are in place for event
- Work proactively with IPM 2025 Local committee on developing water and wastewater plans
- Waive any regional additional permit fees required by IPM 2025
- Provide all required inspections prior to opening and periodic inspections during event as required
- Allow for temporary signage on Regional Roads and properties (event info, directional, welcome signs)

Niagara Regional Police -

- Provide resources to control traffic at the corner of Mud and Mountain Road before/during IPM hours of operations
- Provide paid duty officers at the event as required (additional private security will also be used on site during the event)
- Provide additional NRP resources in the Grimsby/West Lincoln/Lincoln region during the event to align with Emergency Management plan
- Traffic management planning
- Emergency Management planning

Niagara EMS -

- Emergency Management Planning
- Provide EMS services on site as required

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
