A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2024-81, BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES PROVIDED BY THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF NIAGARA AND FOR THE USE OF ITS PROPERTY

WHEREAS section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide;

WHEREAS section 391 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, provides that a municipality may impose fees or charges on persons: for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board; and for the use of its property including property under its control;

WHEREAS By-law No. 2024-81, being a by-law to establish fees and charges for services and activities provided by The Regional Municipality of Niagara and for the use of its property, was passed by Regional Council on December 12, 2024; and,

WHEREAS Regional Council deems it necessary to amend the by-law to add certain fees and charges related to seniors services.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of Niagara enacts as follows:

- 1. That the following fees (amounts inclusive of HST) are added to the seniors services section of the Schedule of Fees and Charges:
 - a. COM-12 Cable TV service at \$55.00 per month;
 - b. COM-13 Internet service at \$40.00 per month;
 - c. COM-14 Cable TV/Internet bundled service at \$85.00 per month; and

2. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on March 1, 2025.
