- Range of services for adults and youth experiencing serious, emerging, or persistent mental illness
 - 2 Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) Teams
 - 1 Flexible Community Treatment (FACT) Team
 - Early Psychosis Intervention
 - Early Intervention for Youth
 - Psychogeriatric Case Management

Housing First ACT (HFACT)

- Support individuals experiencing homelessness, addiction, and mental health challenges
- Provide immediate access to housing without preconditions, followed by comprehensive support services
- Provide intensive services to 80 individuals with the highest needs

Key Principles of HFACT

- Immediate access to permanent housing with no housing readiness requirements
- Consumer choice and self-determination
- Recovery orientation
- Individualized and client-driven supports
- Social and community integration

What Does “Assertive” Mean in HFACT?




- The team must persistently, repeatedly and assertively attempt to engage with a new client for a minimum period of six months before terminating their referral
- At least three months of unsuccessful engagement or service refusal before discharging an active client from service

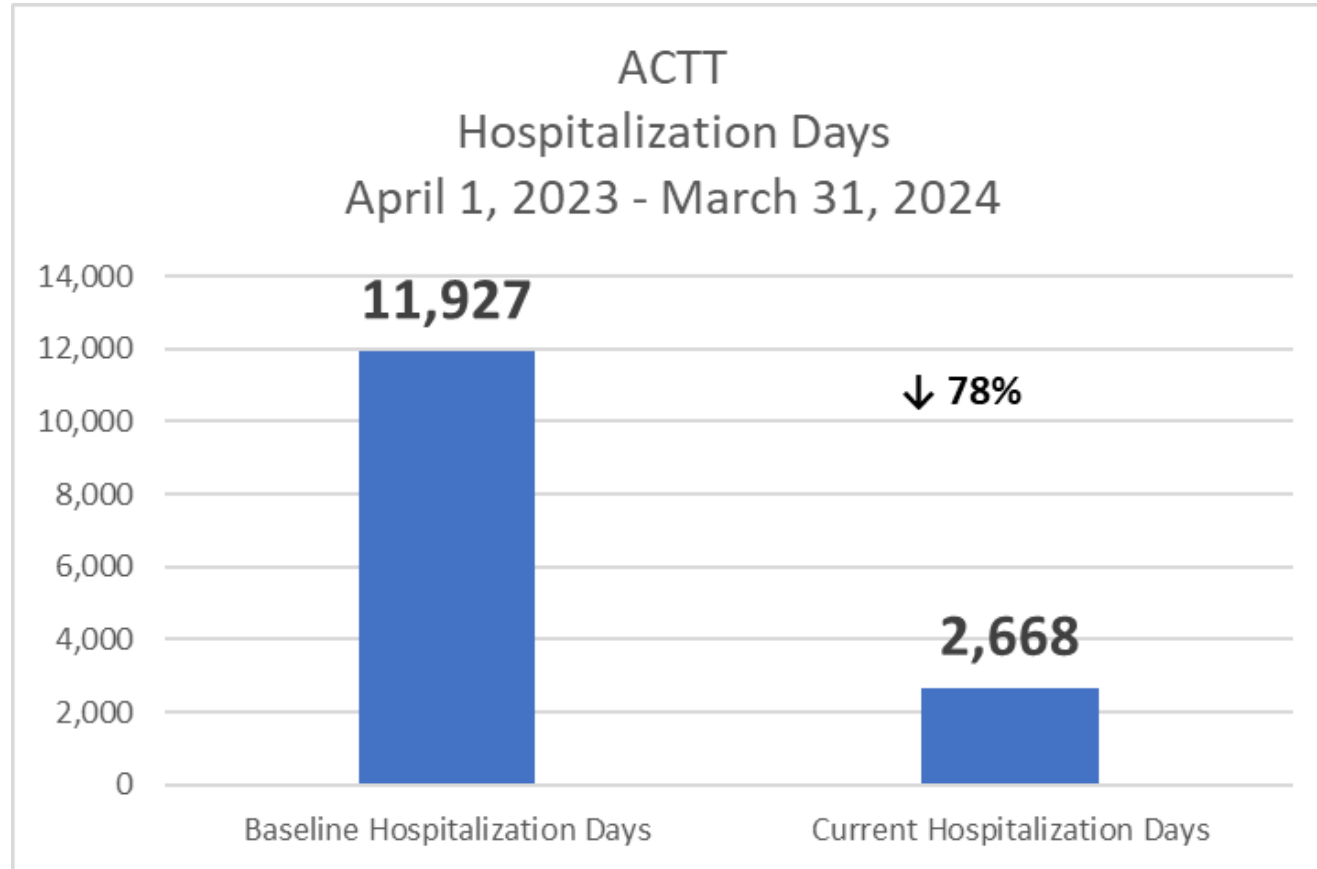

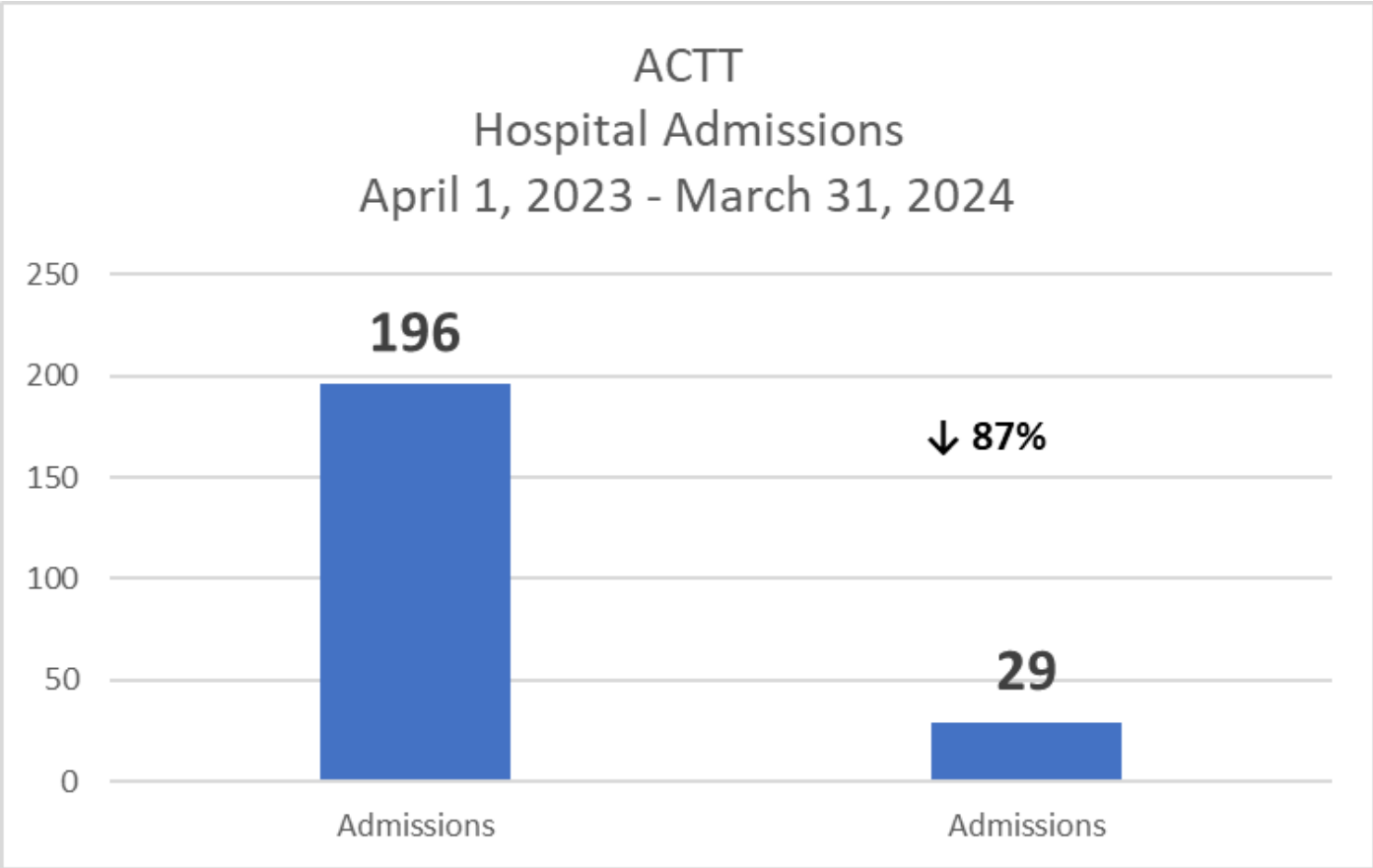
