Overview of the Physician Recruitment Program

01

The Physician
Recruitment Program
works to attract, retain,
and support family
physicians in Niagara to
address primary care
shortages.

In November 2024, the program moved from Public Health to Economic Development, strengthening strategic marketing and outreach efforts.

Works with municipalities, clinic leads, economic development, and health sector partners to coordinate recruitment efforts.

Despite recent recruitment success, ongoing retirements and population growth continue to drive demand for long-term recruitment strategies.





State of Primary Care in Niagara

- Niagara welcome 26 new physicians in 2024 marking a record year for recruitment. 7 more will start in Q1/Q2, 2025.
- 31 physicians are currently accepting patients, the highest number at one time on the Niagara Region's "Find a Doctor" page.
- 2024 was our most successful year on record for physician recruitment, but with Niagara's growing population, we continue working to meet increasing healthcare demands.







Challenges and Opportunities



- Ongoing primary care shortages and increasing patient waitlists
- 14% of current physicians are over 65 and nearing retirement
- Expansion of medical school seats by Ontario Government provides future opportunity
- Strengthened partnerships with municipalities, clinics, and postsecondary institutions





International Recruitment Efforts

- Physician recruitment initiatives in the U.S., U.K., Ireland, and Australia.
- Over 60% of new Niagara physicians recruited from the U.K.
- Key recruitment events in 2024:
 - Career MD Fair (Boston, February 2024) Engaged with specialists and Canadian-trained doctors
 - U.K. Career Fair (Birmingham, June 2024) Connected with 70+ family physicians looking to relocate
 - AAFP Conference (Kansas City, August 2024) Engaged with Canadian students in 175 U.S. medical schools
 - Repatriation Expo (Ireland, October 2024) Connected with 150+ students and health authorities

- Southern Ontario Physician Recruitment Alliance (SOPRA) (Founded September 2023):
- 18 recruitment programs across Ontario Health West
- Shared database and international marketing strategy
- Ontario Physician Recruitment Alliance (OPRA) (Founded April 2024)
