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

## Local Public Health Roles

- 1. Case & Contact Management
- 2. Support Building Health Care System Capacity
  - Maximize Testing
  - Infection Prevention & Control
  - Prepare for Surge of Hospital Demand
  - Health Partners within Social Services Sector
- 3. Public Messaging
  - Amplify Federal & Provincial Messaging (e.g. Travel, Distancing)
  - Inform the Public (risk reduction, testing)
  - Interpret Local Context

  - A few with challenges
- IPAC inspections every 1-2 Weeks
- Enhanced IPAC inspection
- Coaching & Support Team
- Test of Persons with No Apparent Symptoms
- Supporting with Staffing Challenges
- Acute Health Status Assessment Process
